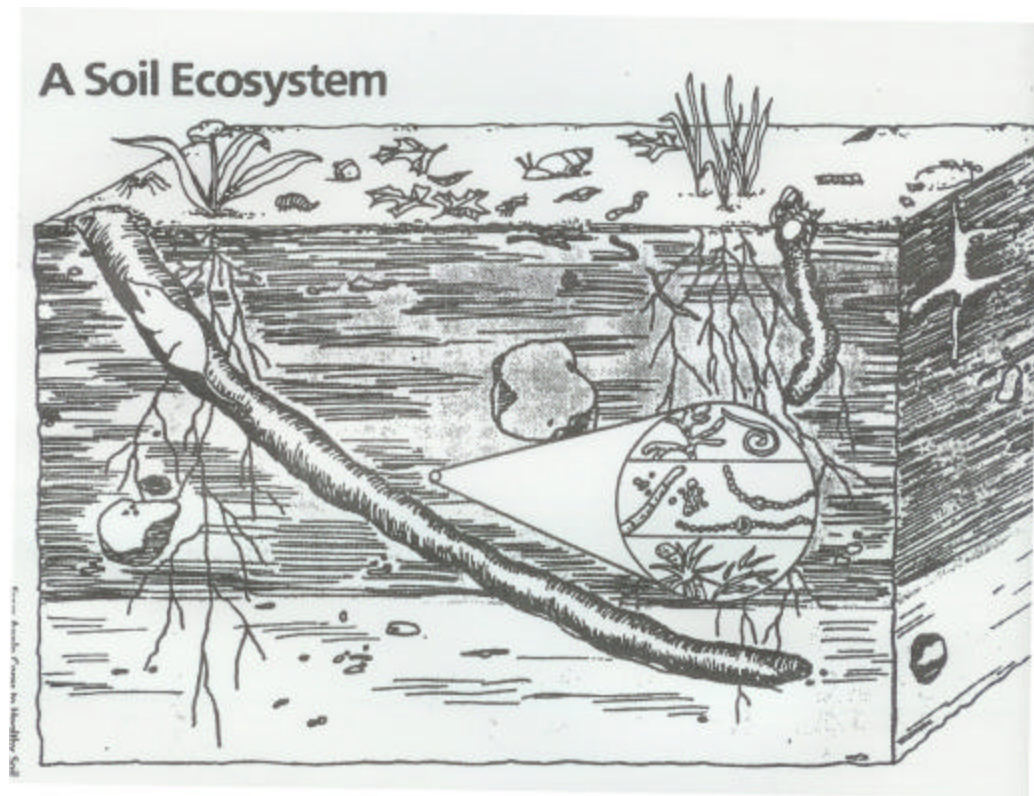

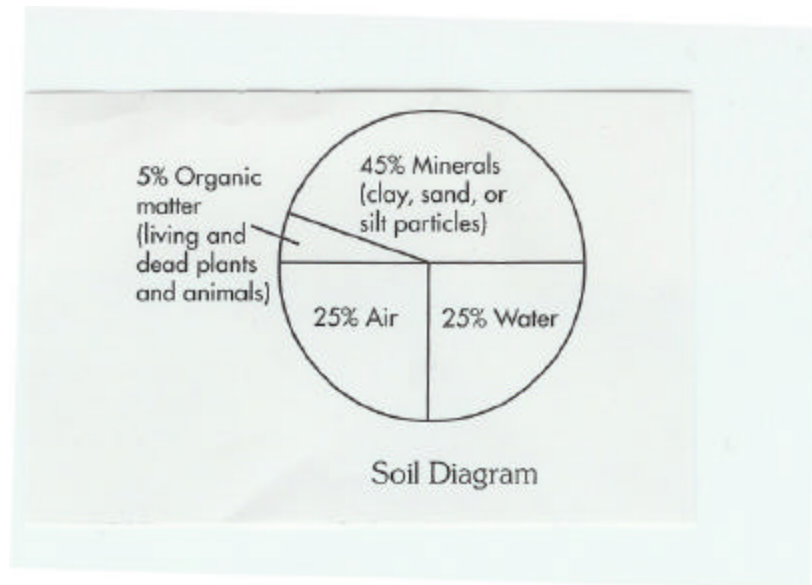
Which organism in the picture is NOT an example of a decomposer?

The compost experiment in Mrs. Garcia's class contained two garbage bags. Each bag was filled with the following materials:

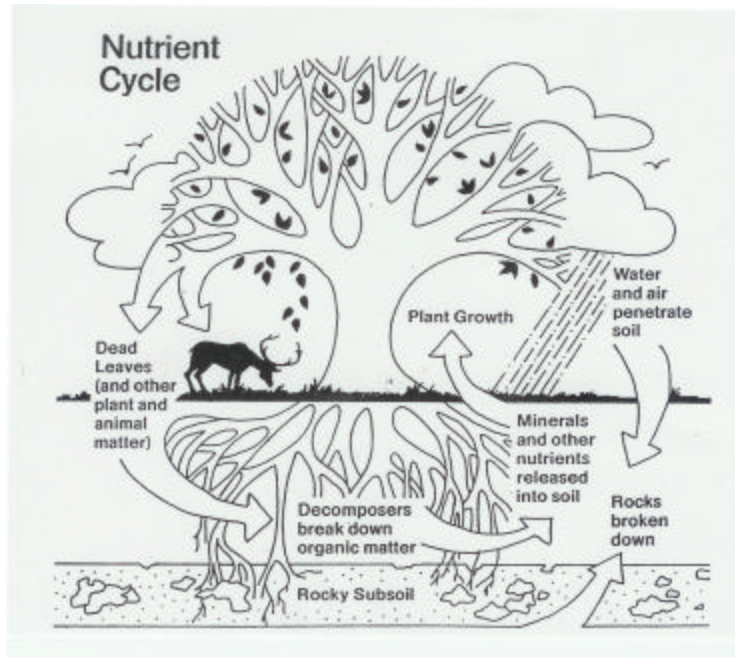
Bag 1: soil, leaves, coffee grinds, apple cores, water
